

QMA CLASSES

Now available to employees of all long-term care facilities

This course is designed to prepare interested employees for the QMA examination and to safely administer medications in a long-term care facility. This class is open to employees of all long-term care facilities.

Class Prerequisites

- High school diploma or GED
- At least 18 years old
- Completed a state approved, 105 hour Certified Nurse Aide Training Program **and** have 1,000 hours of documented work experience in the last 24 months
- Proof of current background check within the past 6 months
- Proof of 2-step Mantoux/TB test
- Able to pass a Math and English test

Classroom Hours

- 60 hours total
- To be held at Westminster Village, West Lafayette
- 4 pm to 9 pm
- **November 7, 9, 16, 19, 21, 28, 30, Dec. 5,7,10, 12, 14. Practicum completed by Feb 10th. Some Saturdays required.**

Practicum

- 40 hours total in 4 hour increments
- The practicum will take place at Westminster Village under supervision of a Licensed Nurse after classroom work is completed. Practicum should occur during a routine "med pass" (typically around meal times). This allows for 10 separate "med pass" experiences and avoids unnecessary hours where medication administration might not occur. Practicum must be completed by Jan 17, 2017.
